





TCA Accreditation in Erasmus + (05.09. – 07.09.2022 in Malta)

Summary of TCA outcomes	This seminar was a contact seminar focused on the application for accreditation organized in collaboration with NOO1 e and LUO1 NAs. It was a hybrid event, including f2f seminars (2 and half full days) and an online follow-up after 2 weeks. We had 60 attendees from 16 countries at our physical seminar and 79 attendees at our online event, including Norwegian attendees who took part in a national TCA prior to the event in Malta. The seminar was attended by SE, VET and AE sectors interested in applying for accreditation, as well as participating institutions that have unsuccessfully requested accreditation in previous calls.
