Dear participants, we are looking forward to the online study visit from Poitiers & Bordeaux in France.

As you may know one of the objectives of this study visit is to provide an opportunity for participants to meet potential future partners to exchange on the topic after the study visit and to develop potential projects.

With this in mind we ask that each participant make a short presentation that gives information on them and their school.

- As we are nearly 40 people, we would like everyone to produce a short self-presentation : 2 minutes/ participant.
- To make it more attractive, we would like each one of the participants to produce only 4 slides, composed with pictures and key words

Slide 1 : who you are, where you work

Slide 2 : who is your audience / learners

Slide 3 : why are you involved in the fight for reducing gender inequalities ?

Slide 4 : your part of creativity : feel free to present something of your own !

- We recommend you to send your presentation to the host organizer for the 20th of May to prevent some technical problems (mail to be precised soon).

LOGGING ON

Initially this training was meant to be implemented face to face, unfortunately due to Covid-19 it now has been transitioned online over two days and a half. Dates are as follows:

- **25th of May: 9.30 am - 4:30 pm (French time)**

- **26th of May : 9:30 am – 3.30pm**

-**27th of May : 9.30- 11.30 am**

We recommend that participants **log a few minutes before** as sessions will begin promptly.

We will use the software MS Teams. It does not necessarily require you to download the app. It can help, but you can directly use it through the Internet. You actually choose what you prefer.

The links will be sent directly to your email address.

Just to let you know, the workshops might be recorded. Do not worry, each time, we will tell you before the beginning of the recording. Moreover, the recordings will only be used for the IH2EF and Erasmus + team in order to realise a report on what would have been achieved. They will not be used for something else than this purpose.

We will have interactive and informal exchanges also using a social meeting digital platform

To maintain more informal moments between group members, we will also invite you to use a complementary platform : wonder.me

It does not require to install any application. A tutorial will be organised for everyone at the end of the first morning.

We kindly remind you some useful tips for a good virtual meeting :

- Please use headphones to avoid noise pollution. We kindly remind you to mute your microphone during presentations and unmute it to give your contributions.

- Feel free to ask questions in the chat, or using the Teams button “Raise your hand” on the Participants tab.
- During the breaks please stay connected with just your Mic and Camera OFF to avoid delays coming back after the break.
- In order to respect schedules, members of the IH2EF will kindly warn speakers 2 minutes before the end of their presentation.
