#### GOALS

- To summarise the results of TCAs and research carried out within the LTA to boost digitalisation in the School Education sector.
- To showcase good practices of project holders.
- To identify the potentials and challenges of emerging trends in school education.
- To empower educators to effectively embrace and integrate digital technologies in the classroom and future projects.

#### COURSE PRE-ACTIVITIES
