Our students

Participate in welcoming of the international students.

Our outgoing students participate in seminars for promoting exchange studies and marketing the exchange programs.

Engagement and activities – Plan various activities and events for students to participate in, both on and off-campus, such as campus tours, information sessions, workshops, social gatherings and International day.

If the students have some ideas for activities, we support them in many cases with the funds.

Communications skills – Student ambassadors develop effective communication skills, including public speaking, writing, and social media etiquette. Encourage them to interact with international students.



Incoming students

How can we include incoming students as ambassadors?

Since 2018 we have a collaboration with a high school in Karlskrona, Chapman gymnasium.

We send incoming Erasmus students to participate in French, German and Spanish language classes.

Once a year, Chapman gymnasiet organise international day – we send invitation to all our international students to participate and present the Erasmus+ program.

The students receive payment for 10 hours each semester and the payment comes student amasador funds.
