





I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to take a moment to express my thoughts on the recent TCA PICEIS event in the spirit of constructive feedback. I appreciate the effort put into organizing the conference; however, I would like to share my concerns and suggestions for improvement.

Thorough Introduction to the Overarching Topic:

It would have been immensely beneficial to have a more comprehensive introduction to the overarching topic of the event. A detailed overview at the beginning would have provided attendees with a clearer understanding of the focus, ensuring more meaningful engagement throughout the conference.

Clarity on Participants' Background and Purpose:

Understanding the diverse backgrounds of attendees, such as whether they were teachers, university staff, ambassadors, or other professionals, and their specific reasons for participating, would have facilitated networking and collaboration. Clear identification of the participants' roles and goals could enhance the relevance of discussions.

Overview of Funding Possibilities:

Providing an overview of available cooperation funding and guidelines on forming partnerships for funding applications would have been invaluable. Knowing who can collaborate for specific types of funding would encourage proactive engagement and project planning.

Encouragement of Audience Diversification:

Despite the stated intention, the audience seemed less diverse than expected. I encourage proactive efforts to diversify attendees in terms of backgrounds, experiences, and perspectives. A more diverse audience enhances the richness of discussions and broadens collective insights.

Clarity in Goals and Expected Outcomes:

Clearly defined goals and expected outcomes would have provided a roadmap for participants. Having specific objectives helps attendees align their contributions, ensuring that the discussions are focused and productive.

Balancing Input and In-Depth Discussions:

The workshop on Day was overloaded with input, leaving limited time for in-depth discussions and critical thinking. A more balanced approach, allowing for interactive sessions and thoughtful reflections, would promote a deeper understanding of the topics and encourage constructive dialogue.

Challenging Set Beliefs and Superficial Discussions:


To foster meaningful discussions, there is a need to challenge established beliefs and encourage participants to delve deeper into the subjects. A more profound exploration of ideas can lead to innovative solutions and transformative outcomes.

All fine, but I prefer venues youth hostels, more rural, with outdoor spaces, cozy places indoor spaces to hang out, and especially where you can open a window for fresh air.

A bit more fresh air would have been helpful. :)

The hotel and services connect were good .

The only critical point is that it should be better that all National Agencies provided in advance for all the participants: some of them did it, some other didn't. The participant should have only the travel payment on himself.

The venue was ideal and very central - though the fact that no windows opened disturbed me a bit (I need fresh air to circulate the rooms - I was rather blocked and very nasal by the end). Another disturbance was the fact that it was only serviced with an elevator and stairs led only to the 3rd floor.

Very noicy in the room when we sat in small groups. I would have been good to have some small rooms for the different groups.

Areas for Improvement:

While food and accomodation were good quality, I would want to highlight a few areas for improvement:

Noise Levels in Conference Room: The conference room was excessively noisy, creating challenges for individuals with hearing difficulties and heightened sensitivity to sensory stimuli. This not only hinders participation but also adds significant stress, making it difficult to engage fully in discussions. A quieter environment is essential for effective communication and learning.


In-Depth Work: The high noise levels in the conference room made it challenging to conduct in-depth work and discussions. A quieter setting would facilitate focused and meaningful conversations, allowing participants to delve deeply into the topics presented.

Group Splitting: I encourage organizers to consider splitting groups more often. Smaller groups facilitate more intimate discussions and ensure that every participant can actively engage, leading to a more enriching experience for everyone involved.

Scented Environment: The scented environment at the location posed a challenge for chemically sensitive individuals, making it difficult for them to attend the conference. It is essential to choose venues that are fragrance-free to accommodate attendees with chemical sensitivities and allergies, ensuring inclusivity for all participants.

Timely Notifications of Acceptance:


Notifications of acceptance were received rather late, which unfortunately led to increased flight costs. Timely communication regarding acceptance statuses can

It would have been useful to go in detail to propose common strategy and common action to realize in different country.

When we used smaller areas for group discussions it was not so noisy. Organising discussions with time keeper and a moderator to let everyone get to talk would be great.

In my opinion it could have been favorably to incorporate the body more. An easy suggestion is to have a one minute body activity between every presentation. I believe just standing up and shaking a bit would improve the concentration and motivation in the room!

Paul Blokker and Arjan Verdooren were been very performing facilitators toward raise awarness. They took and spoke about different pov of civic engagement and social/cvultural exclusions.

The balance between theory and practice has been perfect. All working sessions, the materials and tools provided were extremely successful.

The content was good but there wasn't enough time for the exercices. Content provided by Paul was way too abstract for many participants.


Inclusivity of the event was somhow missing, inclusing speakers, etc.




Very clear and interesting.



We are now applying for accreditation for the theoretical education, there I have written in as one of the objectives "Democratic and civil engagement". We will also change one of our objectives in the vocational accreditation (that we already have) so that the objective also will be there so that we can engage the whole school.


