












What Do We Do with an international perspective?



- Encouraging sustainable travel and developing sustainability in VET mobility. Through KA2: <u>ENVIRASMUS</u>. Will be implemented in all mobilities and across AcadeMedia's schools in Sweden.
 Since 2022 we have a sustainability plan connected with our internationalisation plan.
- Promoting inclusion. Learners selected transparently and according to suitability. Academic performance not the only consideration.
 We provide extra funding and support for learners with fewer opportunities. Always accompanied Erasmus+ Mobilities (not Pro).

PROCESS MANAGEMENT AND FACILITATION
