Objectives

- high quality education and research
- respecting the particularities and traditions of different disciplines



Summary of figures

- turnover of nearly 2 billion SEK (one quarter through research)
- 100 programmes, 390 courses
- 25 000 students / year
- 2 200 employees
- approximately 260 doctoral student
- approximately 500 teachers with a PhD
- 110 professors



Students at Malmö University

- two out of three students are first generation university students
- four out of ten students have a non-Swedish background
- many international students (one out of ten)
- multiple pathways – flexibility and life-long learning
- nine out of ten enter the labour market after graduation



Education at Malmö University

Aims to:

- contribute to inclusion and student empowerment
- contribute to making education and lifelong learning an integral part of society as a whole
- develop students' ability to critically evaluate knowledge and translate it into action.

UNIC – European University Alliance

- UNIC (European University of Cities in Post-Industrial Transition) is an alliance within the European Universities Initiative, EU Commission's vision to create new collaboration opportunities for higher education institutions and increased exchange opportunities for students and staff.
- UNIC is an identity-driven alliance of 10 universities in post-industrial cities with a 'superdiverse' population. The member universities work closely with their home cities.
- For Malmö University, UNIC provides opportunities to strengthen international collaboration in research and education and to further deepen collaboration with the City of Malmö.
