PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1. TCA general information

This TCA is a seminar co-organized by the French Erasmus+ Agency and CCCA-BTP. The CCCA-BTP is in charge of all administrative management, follow-up and accompaniment of all participants, as well as the various logistical aspects (platform, registration, hotel, accommodation, etc.). It calls on an external event service provider.

As soon as you are selected, the CCCA-BTP and its service provider (Plus Voyages) will contact you directly to register you, obtain your agreement in terms of RGPD and image rights, integrate your "participants" profile on a platform for presentation and choice of workshops, networking, etc.

All questions relating to your accommodation and stay should be addressed to the CCCA-BTP service provider.

2. Registration, profile presentation and online networking platform

An online platform will be opened before the start of the TCA.

If you are selected by your own agency, you will then be contacted to complete a registration form on our online platform.

The platform will allow you to publish your participant profile: identity, photo, information about your organization/institution, etc.

This information will enable participants to discover the profiles of others before they arrive, so as to optimize the search for partners and networking. We will ask you to upload a short presentation in English (Word, PDF) about your organization and its educational project, your expectations, your ideas, etc.

Finally, you will have the opportunity to make an appointment in advance with the person(s) of your choice. Time and space will be set aside for networking meetings, independently of any other informal opportunities for discussion.

This networking process (which has already been tried and tested on other TCAs) will only be a success if everyone takes special care to complete the forms, add a presentation, respond to requests for appointments, etc. We're counting on you!

3. Dates and times

- Arrival expected on Monday 6 October 2025 *before 15:00, check in at the hotel*
- Departure on Thursday 9 October 2025 *after lunch around (14:00) from the hotel*

Travel arrangements should be made accordingly to avoid arriving after the start of the TCA and leaving before the end.

The French agency & CCCA-BTP will directly cover the following costs (from date to date and at the times indicated), on an all-inclusive basis:

you want to arrive before or leave after the date indicated of the TCA

- Neither the French agency nor CCCA-BTP or its event service provider will take care of the management and follow-up of any additional overnight stays you may have.
- In this case, these extra nights **must be booked directly by yourself**, in agreement with your national sending agency, at the **hotel of your choice** directly with the **Resort Barrière Lille**.
- For information, the tourist tax at the hotel is around €4,00/night/person.



Don't hesitate to let us know about your **particular needs**: reduced mobility, hearing or sight impaired, etc.



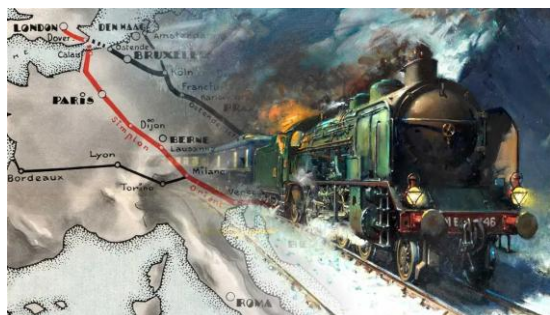
Any dietary restrictions will be considered (allergies, intolerance, etc.).

For French participants

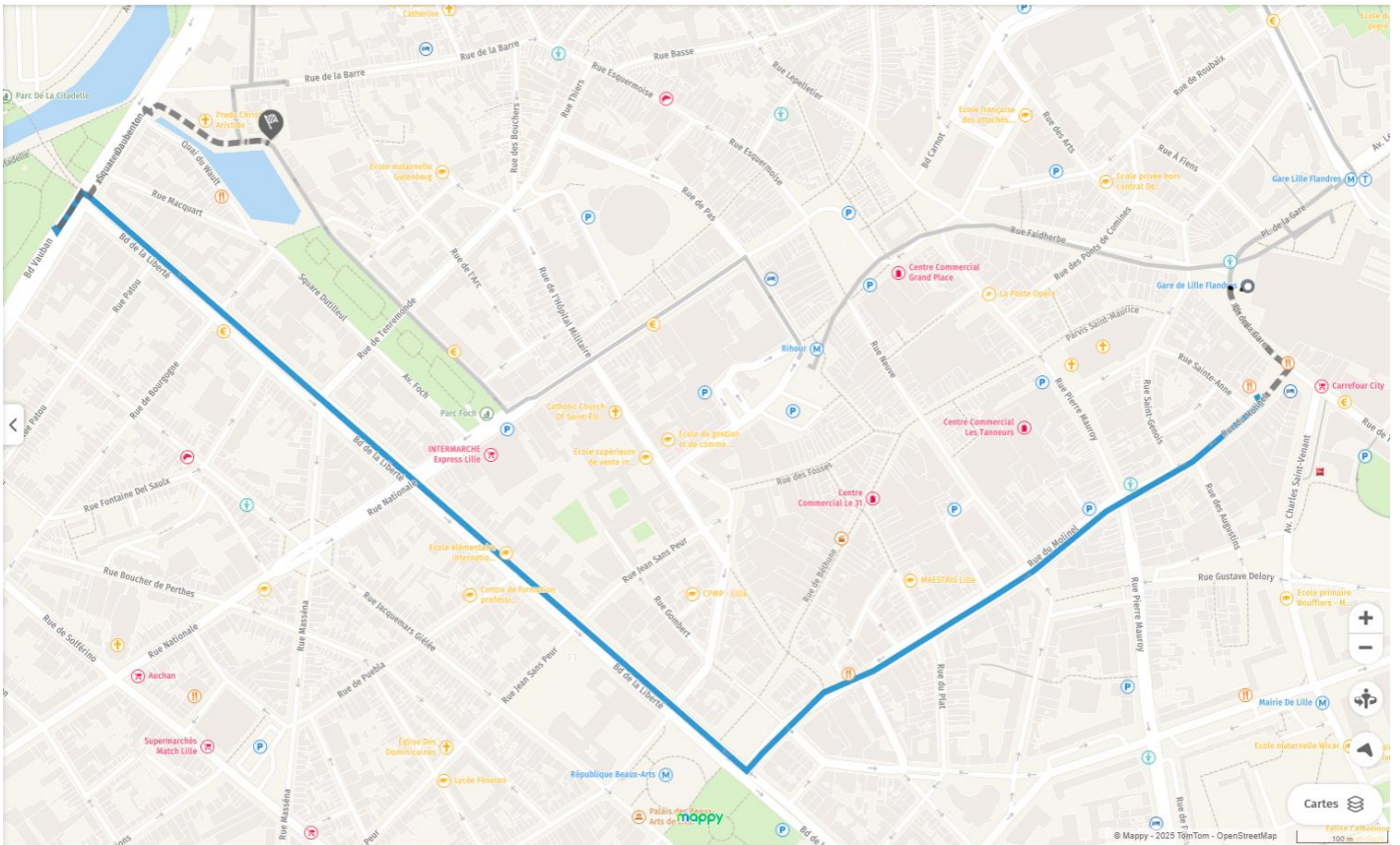
From France, you can reach Lille **by train** (transport to be favoured):

For European participants

From European countries, it's possible to land at Paris-Roissy-Charles de Gaulle international airport.

The city of Lille can be reached **by TGV train directly from Roissy-Charles de Gaulle airport (terminal 2) in less than an hour**. Arrival at Lille Flandres railway station.

From the Lille railway station (Lille Flandres), the journey takes 16 minutes by bus with a 6-minute walk

From the Lille-Lesquin airport, you can then take the **Shuttle public bus Lille Airport - Lille city centre**
