CAMPUS INTERNATIONAL 2025 Impact of Higher Education Student Mobility

This study surveyed students from 16 European countries. The central question was to what extent study-related stays abroad help to prepare students for the labour market.

Based on the available research findings, study-related stays abroad can be credited with having significant effects on students' skills and qualities relevant to the labour market. Through dialogue with partners, stakeholders and researchers, the aim is to discuss what implications the findings (should) have at a policy level, and which questions a follow-up project should focus on or add.
