- Positive emotions (P) - How can I make sure there is positive emotion regardless of the environment - digital, hybrid, f2f, etc.?
- Engagement (E) - How can I maximise engagement in digital/hybrid environment?
- Relationships (R) - How do I incorporate social interactions in my digital existence?
- Meaning (M): How can I ensure meaningful collaboration?
- Accomplishment (A): How can I accomplish my goals in the digital environment?
