The seminar begins on Sunday, 25 January, in the late afternoon with networking activities, followed by a joint welcome dinner. Full seminar days are scheduled for Monday, 26 January and Tuesday, 27 January, concluding with a farewell dinner on Tuesday evening. Departures are planned for the morning of Wednesday, 28 January, after breakfast. Full participation throughout the seminar is expected. The Austrian National Agency will cover accommodation for three nights (25-27 January) at Hotel Altstadt in Vienna, which is also the seminar venue. All meals and the social programme during the seminar are included.
