and self-directed learning; Spark reflection on European values and themes; Explore tools on how to support the inclusion of Roma communities enrolment in European projects. Key Topics Covered The legal and funding frameworks for Roma integration; Working in multicultural settings - exchanging good practices for engaging young people, students, and parents, including national-specific approaches; Mentoring, coaching and volunteering - effective models for collaboration between youth workers, educators, parents, students, and mediators; Tackling aggression and boosting motivation; Inspiring motivation for participation in Erasmus+ and ESC projects - with concrete examples and

success stories; Tools to include Roma community in European projects.

This goal will be achieved through a four-day cross-sectoral training event, which will provide in-depth insight into the tools and opportunities offered by the Erasmus+ Programme and the European Solidarity Corps (ESC). The aim is to support the effective inclusion of Roma communities and to equip participants with practical skills for facilitating integration. The training is targeted at:Youth organisations;Organisations working with people with fewer opportunities; Vocational schools and high schools; Informal youth groups.
