Themes and goals:	Themes and Goals: This cross-sectoral thematic contact making seminar is aimed at supporting organisations seeking funding under the KA2 Action, Cooperation Partnerships (KA220). The event will provide participants from across Programme countries with the opportunity to work together and develop their project ideas and solutions using a Design Thinking approach. By attending, participants will gain a deeper understanding of their education and training needs, as well as develop innovative solutions that may be potentially financed through Erasmus+. The event will feature an overview of Design Thinking and its application to Erasmus+ project development, practical workshops to guide participants through the project design process, information sessions on approaching partnership applications, and networking and collaboration opportunities.
