### TCA DESCRIPTION

<b>Themes and goals:</b>	<p>This is a TCA focused on the value and importance of Transversal Skills and the role that Erasmus+ can play in facilitating and accelerating the development of these skills. According to business research, March - September 2020 represented the equivalent of a decade of accelerated progress in terms of digitisation and work practice. Now, post-Covid, there is broad recognition that Transversal Skills have a key role to play in helping people to navigate a rapidly changing world. It will address how to leverage the programme in support of the development of Transversal Skills.
