TCA DESCRIPTION

Themes and goals:	This contact making seminar aims to bring together secondary school teachers (of pupils aged 12-18 years), from across Europe and Ireland, that are interested in applying for a future KA1 mobility project particularly Long-Term Pupil Mobility. Participants will work together to explore innovative and alternative forms of civic and democratic participation of pupils and be inspired to create new mobility partnerships and networks in which they will play a role as either a sending or receiving institution in future projects. The event will provide an opportunity to explore "know how" strategies in relation to long term learning mobility projects that encourage civic engagement among pupils, and which promote the recognition of learning and experience acquired during a mobility opportunities to learn how exchanges can effectively involve and engage students in the process of bringing civic engagement, democracy and active participation into classrooms.
