TCA DESCRIPTION

Themes and goals:	<p>This is primarily a contact seminar which aims at bringing together organisations, from across Europe, that are active in the field of adult education and more specific in the disability sector interested in applying for a future KA1 mobility project or a small-scale partnership. The event will provide an opportunity to meet with other providers from the host country whilst promoting future projects that can increase the participation of in Erasmus+ mobility (including among adults with fewer opportunities), especially those mobility projects that encourage inclusion among adult learners and which promote the recognition of learning and experience acquired during a mobility period. Furthermore, participants will be introduced in the Erasmus+ programme and the possibilities in mobility and partnerships (objectives, funding, regulation, etc.) will increase their network and work together to explore future partnerships or mobilities between their organisations can follow key notes on the topic of inclusion in E+ and the disability sector.
