To achieve the above objectives the new Programme has been designed to make it easier for organizations to access. With Erasmus accreditation, organizations only need to be accredited once to receive funding for Key Action 1 mobility activities during the seven years of the Programme. Key Action 1 supports organizations in delivering professional and personal development opportunities for learners, teachers and trainers and other education staff. Each Erasmus Accreditation covers one of three fields of education:1.Adult Education (Including formal, informal and non-formal education)2.Vocational Education and Training (Including initial and continuing vocational education (Including early childhood education and care, pre- primary, primary and secondary schools)For further information please refer to the Padlet Platform of the LTA cooperation.
