Inspiration for the future work and European projects on the topic. Starting cooperation that will lead to applying for KA210-funding in October 2022. Our primary goal is that, by the end of the seminar, every participant has found a KA210-partner on the subject. Our secondary goal is to host at least 50% of newcomers to Erasmus+. Our third goal is that at least 12 partnerships emerge from the seminar

The seminar is mainly targeted at teachers, leaders and others working with children in pre-primary and lower primary school (age 1-9), who are interested in learning how to start a small scale partnership in Erasmus+. Thus, the institutions they represent are interested in engaging in a KA210 Partnership. "Other working with children" might be librarians (both school librarians and staff of public libraries), music/art schools, NGOs,

etc.Participants should have good command of English. Participants should have no or little experience in Erasmus+ (ex. They can only have been coordinator once and/or only have been in 3 partnerships).
