TCA DESCRIPTION

Themes and goals:	The current Covid-19 pandemic has forced students and academics to switch to online teaching modes. Thus the process of digitalisation in higher education has evolved rapidly. In 2020, the European Commission published a special call for proposals for Strategic Partnerships focusing on digitalisation, inviting universities and other stakeholders to prepare and submit digitalisation projects. Digitalization is visible in different areas of HEIs' activities: teaching, research, serving to society, internal management. This was expressed in the submitted proposals.
