TCA DESCRIPTION

Themes and goals: The event focuses on strengthening young people's participation in democratic life, with a particular emphasis on the role of EuroApprentices as active ambassadors of European values. The main goal is to create a space for meaningful dialogue, exchange of experiences, and mutual learning among participants from different countries. We aim to foster a deeper understanding of democratic principles, civic engagement, and the importance of active participation in society. Through interactive sessions and study visits, participants will explore how democratic values are reflected in both historical and contemporary contexts. An important objective of the event is also to support the development of strong interpersonal connections, encourage collaboration, and build a sense of European community. By bringing together engaged young people, we want to empower them to become more confident, active, and responsible citizens who contribute to democratic life at local, national, and European levels.

Expected results: As a result of the event, participants will strengthen their understanding of democratic values and increase their awareness of the importance of civic participation. They will gain new knowledge, skills, and inspiration that will support their further activities as EuroApprentices. Participants will also develop practical ideas and tools for promoting Erasmus+ and active citizenship in their local communities. The event will enhance their communication, teamwork, and intercultural competences. Another key outcome will be the creation of stronger networks among EuroApprentices from different countries. Establishing these connections will encourage future cooperation, exchange of good practices, and joint initiatives beyond the event itself. Additionally, participants will leave the event with concrete plans on how to use the knowledge gained and how to multiply the impact of the experience after returning to their countries.

Additional information:

The event will combine educational, networking, and inspirational elements. It will include interactive workshops, group discussions, and study visits to places of high historical and social importance related to democracy and civic movements. A special added value of the event will be the opportunity to engage directly with inspiring figures and institutions connected to democratic transformation. This will provide participants with a unique perspective on how individual and collective actions can shape democratic societies. The programme is designed to be highly participatory, giving participants space to share their own experiences, reflect on their role as EuroApprentices, and actively contribute to the learning process. Overall, the event aims not only to provide knowledge but also to build motivation, a sense of responsibility, and long-lasting connections among participants.
