The event is designed as a training course on how to write a successful application, combined with elements of a classic contact making seminar.</p>

The event will place the participants in the centre of the learning process through interactive methods while focusing on the understanding of the concepts and specifics of working in transnational cooperation projects. The activities will be led by experienced facilitators with a broad understanding of the learning process and strategic partnerships under Erasmus+.</li> </ul>
