1. Welcome and introduction of the new members

Kriszta Molnár, Head of TCA Resource Centre

Warmly greeted the Working Group (WG) with its new five members. Emphasized that the WG is an outstandingly important partner to the SALTO E&T as all plans and concepts are discussed with the Board and their feedback guide the processes followed.

4. Main directions of the training and research concept

Trainings

- Target groups: TCA Officers, NA staff, experts/trainers
- Topics: Topics of TCA lifecycle; About TCA programme for TCA staff; Thematic trainings around TCA priorities; EU policy and actualities; Competence development; Training of trainers
- Form of trainings
- Other issues to consider

Research

- Investigating
 - how successful TCAs are;
 - whether they contribute to increasing the quality of E+
- Tools:
 - monitoring NA's TCA related work by interviews and questionnaires
 - Impact assessment of TCAs

Discussion – Training and Research concept

- FI volunteered to support SALTO in organizing online or f2f trainings
- Most of the NAs showed their interest in research contribution: MT, DE
 - NAs which discuss the opportunity within their NAs: PT, NL
- Considering having a research working group for organization tasks, and have SALTO E&T as coordinator (not necessarily from WG members)
- NAs which are analysing results and offered to share materials: IT, MT
- WG proposed the idea of working with a professional researcher

5. TCA officers' meeting concept 2019

Kata Albrecht-Garai, Senior Coordinator at TCA Resource Centre

- Date: expectedly in end May 2019
- Focus: Quality in TCA:
 - ➤ What does quality mean in TCA?
 - ➤ How does quality appear in TCA?
 - How should quality be further improved in TCA?
- Venue: Netherlands



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• Structure of the meeting: 1+2+1? (training+ meeting+ WG meeting or WG meeting+ meeting+ training)

Content and form of the meeting

- TCA planning
 - Learning islands idea: topics to be explored in before
 - Good practices to present
- Knowledge transfer, presentations on a hot issue
 - Hot issues to collect (WG)
- Additional training day
- WG personal meeting

Discussion – TCA officers meeting

- Agreed that the next topic shall be Quality in TCAs, but evaluation and cooperation among TCA officers in the selection of participants was also proposed.
- TCA officers meeting shall be advertised much earlier than the event date in order to allow officers to attend
- At the youth meeting this year, a TCA officer training was introduced the day before the
 meeting on those aspects of how to run a TCA and sharing basic TCA management
 approaches. This was optional but very successful and meant all officers attending the
 officers meeting with an agreed knowledge level. → could implement this
- The **TCA officers meeting** then **focused** more fully **on quality**, inspirational talks and thematic activity development → could implement this
- There should be a **SALTO E&T platform training** organized
- possible subjects:
 - Need **information from the EC** during the meeting: eg: Next programme actualities are a very hot issues to be informed by the EC
 - > A training on the platform use could be also be an important topic
 - ➤ How to improve the quality of the event
- The youth meeting also followed an **open agenda format from the second day** where any officer can put forward topics they wish to discuss → could implement this
- Tools and materials shared (by UK): <u>Learning island</u>, <u>Open agenda through Google form</u>, <u>Open agenda formalized to padlet</u>
- Youth practice: use 2 external facilitators
- Consider WG's further role in planning and supporting the TCA officers' meeting
 - > WG members discuss it within the NA

6. Next steps

By SALTO

- Week starting with 26th November 2018: Sending the Training and Research concept survey to NAs
- Making the former impact survey available.
- Q4 2018: communicate the newest SALTO E&T platform developments, update User Manual







- Q4 2018 or Q1 2018: organize platform webinars
- Q2 2018: organize the TCA officers meeting focusing on Quality (and evaluation) and implement agreements mentioned at "Discussion TCA officers meeting"

By WG
