The idea of the Erasmus+ Academy

A place, where you can access training programmes for beneficiaries, which through TCA

- **support beneficiaries** to run their European projects;
- have a focus on rather **general management** and European issues;
- are only covering issues which are relevant for a **longer period**;

TCAs are **managed jointly** by a number of NAs.

Suitable TCA topics for the Erasmus+ Academy could be:

- European Project Management for KA1 or KA2 projects
- Impact
- Dissemination
- Internationalisation

The **Erasmus+ Academy** is a brand to promote this approach.

An example:

TCA Internationalisation strategies in VET

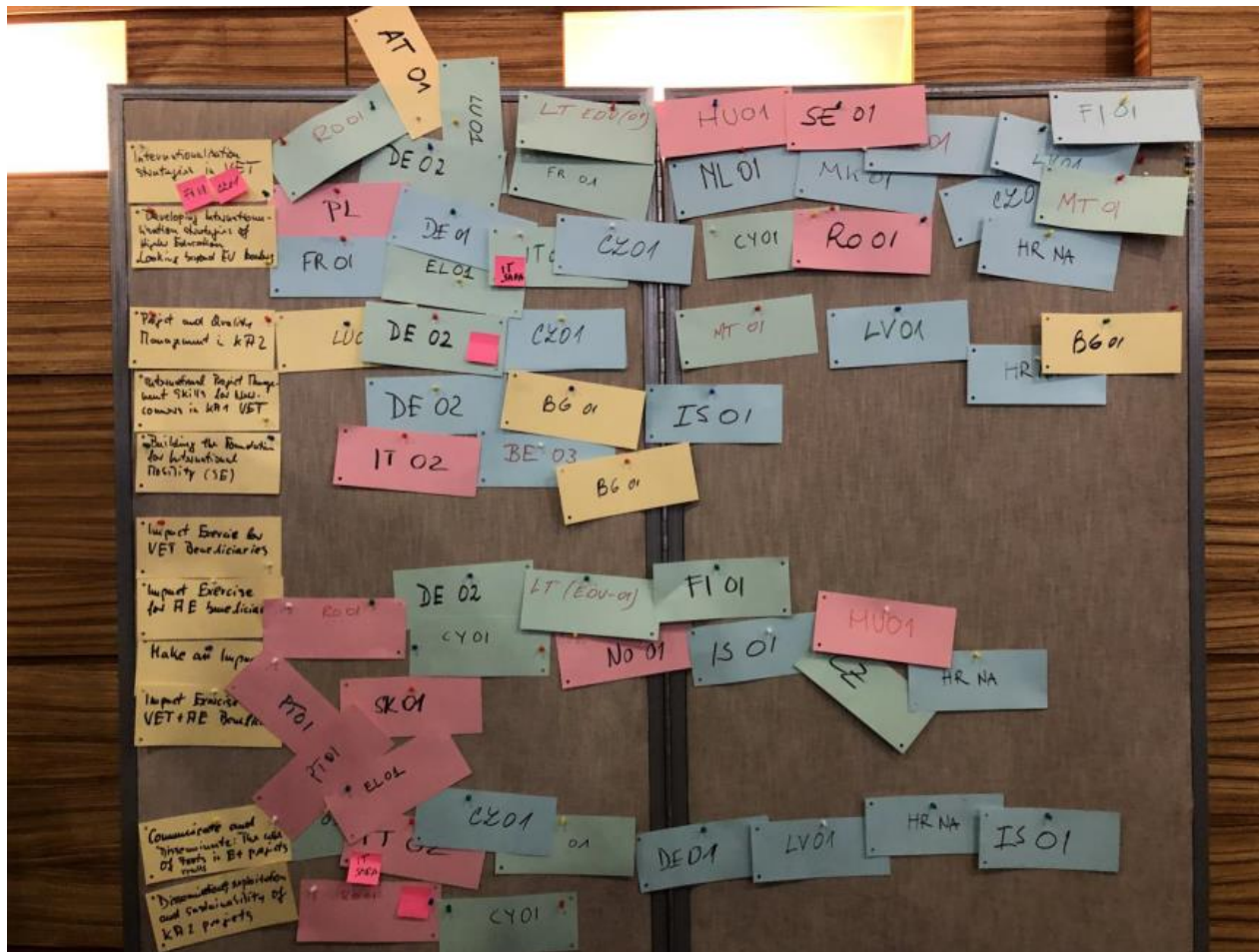
- A concept developed by the Dutch, Finnish, and Hungarian NA

- The advantages:
 - a proved concept
 - same experts/facilitators
 - assured spaces for participants
 - continuous quality improvement

The expected benefits of Erasmus+ Academy labelled projects:

- Commitment from a group of NAs to carry out a specific TCA several times
- Continuity
- Easier planning and organisation
- A pool of experts
- A chance for small NAs to carry out (more) TCAs

A result from the Directors' Meeting in Bukarest (April 2019)



Let's make the Erasmus+ Academy operational!

1. A TCA from the list will become an Erasmus+ Academy TCA under the condition that at least three NAs volunteer for the TCA. This guarantees that the TCA will be offered several times and that NAs share the burden organising a TCA.
2. Is your NA listed correctly? Please add or delete your NA from the list
3. Topic „internationalisation“: Please relate your NA to one or several of the listed model TCA.

Let's make the Erasmus+ Academy operational!

4. NA who are committed to the same TCA please create a network to support each other:
 - a. One or two NA agree to run this TCA in 2020 and include it in their work programme. The NAs of the network act as co-organizer;
 - b. Invite the NA of the network to join the TCA by sending staff to support you carrying out the TCA;
 - c. Exchange contact details of colleagues from NAs interested and collect additional material for the TCA;

5. Start a process to create a pool of experts (internal or external experts) who could act as facilitator for this TCA (this does not mean that they do all the work).

Let's make the Erasmus+ Academy operational!

6. TCA resource Centre: Create a space on the platform where resources in relation to a Erasmus+ academy TCA can be stored and are accessible to NA. NAs who were already running this type of TCA are requested to provide material which helps the network to carry out the TCA and to improve them. Of special interests are the agenda of the TCA, any kind of materials, information about working methods and the evaluation of the TCA including feedback from participants.
