 - Open: https://tinyurl.com/tca2019map
 - Put a pin to the map where you're working at (NA address)
 OR type the address in the textbox and Add to the map
 - Write your name to the upper textbox (with bold)
 - Description box: describe your institution, your role, the sector you are involved, the TCA experience (briefly) and have some personal comments (hobbies, family)
 - Save your pin
