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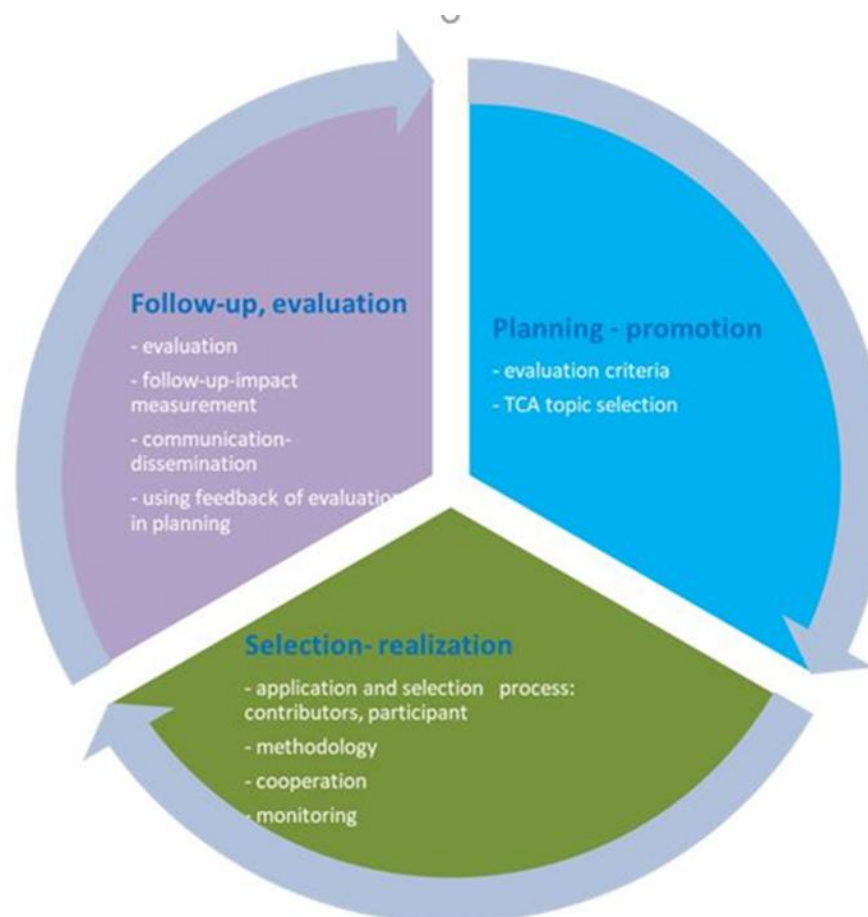

1: Planning & Promotion

- Selecting the Right Participants
 - Devoted + Really Interested in the Topic
 - ~~Participate~~ → Needs Analysis to select objective & Goals of TCA.

2. Selection / Realisation

- Involvement of Organisations for their Contribution

3. Follow-up & Evaluation

- Evaluation form right after Concluding TCA
- Evaluation form after 6 months
- Holding other Activities such as Migrant / Refugee Day

Contact seminar

1. Phase-Preparation

- ↳ e-trimming as a tool for connecting before the meeting
- "Participants profiles"

2. Implementation

- ↳ Interactive moments and Promote activities
 - European Market, singing or dancing contributions, ice-breaking activities
- ↳ Content: thematic tables, best practice create posters, training on how to apply

3. Follow-up

- ↳ Project teams and project proposals on the e-trimming platform to start projects

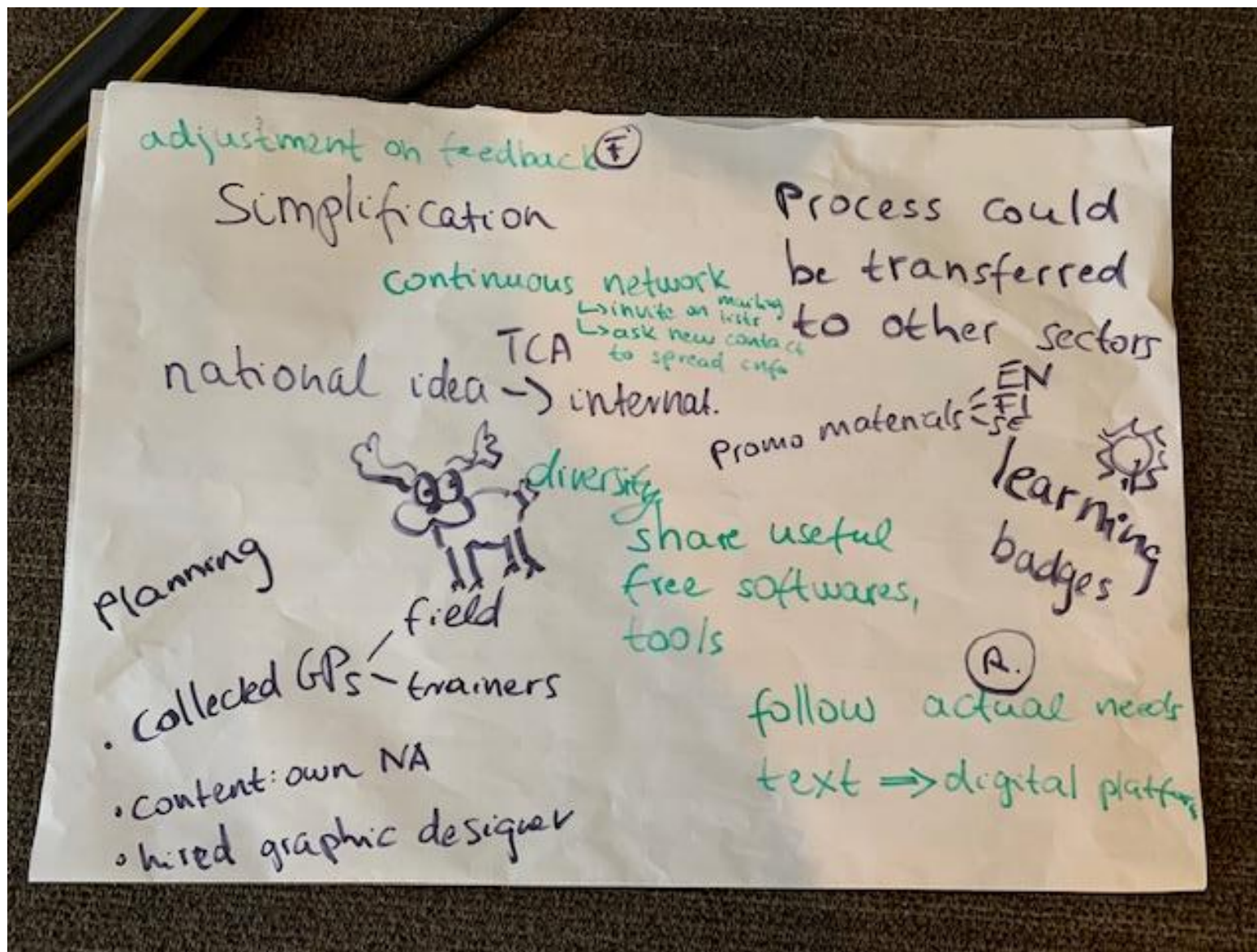

Digital Competences

- Cross-sectoral, focusing on KA2
- The NA decides on a theme and then asks for ideas from the applicants.
The ideas can be very vague at this point.
- About 70 participants - perhaps 8 from Estonia

Why is this a good practice?

- The Estonian NA is considered a force in the subject of digital competences. It has expertise and experience on the subject and this touches all the parts of the TCA cycle.
 - a good example of planning is creating a closed space on the web for all participants in advance.
 - a good example of follow-up is online evaluation sent to all participants
 - the expert is really important in the realisation phase, listening to the ideas and giving immediate feedback
