What is an LTA TCA? What are TCA's...? You are in it now!

- TCA=Transnational Training and Cooperation Activities
- TCA:s are tools for <u>National Agencies</u> (NAs) to form partnerships and to contribute to achieving the aims of the <u>Erasmus+ programme</u>.







TCAs are strategical cooperation activities for the National Agencies to:

- Increase the general awareness of the Erasmus+programme
- Inspire people to apply for mobility and/or cooperation projects within Erasmus+
- TCAs is a tool to make it possible to reach the objectives and priorities for the Erasmus+ programme: a first step, even a second and a third step
- You increase your knowledge, you exchange experience, you create networks and contacts
- You learn more about how to use the possibilites for international cooperation
- TCAs are contact seminars, thematic seminars, study visits, peer-learning and LTAS
- LTA TCAs are transnational and national activities in a longer perspective (3-4 years)





Long term, accreditation – why working in this way?

- Accreditation is built upon a strategic plan for a long term development of competences and mobilities for staff and pupils in your organisations
- With your strategic plan you apply for a budget, a yearly financial support for your activities in your plan
- A change from an individual way of thinking to a more strategic, long term, "several years" planning for increased school or organisational development by international cooperation linked to the competences of staff and pupils
- The competence development and the international exchanges are meant to be integrated in the "daily life" of your organisation and to be recurrent
- The same goes for the LTAs: strategic, long term, increase cooperation, awareness, possibilites and simplifications
- The results, the outcomes and the continuation


